QENP enjoys a fabulous rift valley setting between lakes George and Edward at the foot of the Rwenzori mountain. A variety of habitats, including savannah, acacia woodland, forest, wetland, & open water supports a wide range of mammal & bird species.



SEMLIKI

In the broad Semilki Valley, on the far side of the Rwenzon, East African grasslands merge with Congolese forest. Semilki National Park contains the eastern limit of this hot, steamy jungle and is crammed with unfamiliar forest birds. A primates from the Congo. **D**B

RWENZORI MOUNTAINS

A frica's highest mountain range, the 5100m Rwenzori - or Mountains of the Moon - is the snowy source of the Nile referred to by early geographers. Trails to the snow peaks ascend glacier-carved valleys filled with colourful mosses & glant forms of lobelias, heathers and groundsels.

This ancient forest in Uganda's mountainous south western corner has been weaving itself into tangles for 25,000 years, in the process accumulating an extraordinary biodiversity. Species counts list 350 birds, 310 butterflies, 200 trees, 51 reptiles and 120 mammals, including the rare and unforgettable mountain contila.

MGAHINGA GORILLA

The tiny (33km²) N.P. protects a variety of ting mountain gorillas & golden monkeys, on the Ugandan siopes of the Virunga volcanoes.



LAKE MBURO

Uganda's smallest savanna park contains a scenic mosaic of grassland, wetland, acacia woodland and open water. A variety of herbivores include species, including eland, impala and zebra, that are rare or absent from other Ugandan parks.









This massive extinct volcano was once Africa's highest mountain, towering above Killimaniaro's present 589 Im. Though reduced to 4321m, Mt. Elgon's emblematic tiers of waterfall-streaked basalt cliffs still rise 3000m above the surrounding plains, ascending through altitudinal bands of forest,
